

VBT Clerk's Office Hosts the 2015 Belleville High Student Council Election

On Tuesday May 12, 2015 the Van Buren Charter Township Clerk's Office transformed the Belleville High School Cafeteria into a polling location for the 2015 Student Council Election. Graduating seniors served as poll workers checking student identification, issuing ballots and guiding participants through the election process. The class of 2015 has experienced this "real life" voting experience through their entire academic career celebrating a milestone for the project. Of the 1309 eligible voters sixty percent cast their vote. Twenty six students became registered voters and eleven Election Inspector applications were completed. Since the inception of the project the VBT Clerk's Office has seen an increase in the number of votes cast during Elections held in the community by voters in the age 18-21 range. This year's Student Council Election was made possible through a generous donation by the Cozzad Rotary Foundation and the support of the Van Buren Public School District.
