The Van Buren Township Clerk's Office Proudly Presents a Life like Voting Experience for the Belleville High School Student Council Election

On May 14, 2013 the Belleville High School Athletic Atrium will be transformed into a polling location where students will participate in voting for members of the Belleville High Student Council. Students will serve as poll workers checking student identification and issuing ballots. Each participate will be provided a coded ballot and directed to a voting booth to mark their selection. Ballots will be entered into one of two M100 voting tabulators and votes will be tallied electronically at the end of the Election Day.



It is our desire to introduce young people to the voting process by partnering with Van Buren Public Schools to bring the actual voting experience encountered at polling locations throughout the community. This project also allows students to experience roles they would encounter when serving as precinct inspectors. Our goal in providing this true to life experience is to encourage a lifelong commitment to voting and participation in the voting process.
