**MINUTES - DRAFT**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Denton Room by Chairperson Brownlee.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Motion Trustee White, Second Commissioner Debuck to approve the minutes of August 21, 2019 as presented. Motion Carried

**COMMUNICATIONS:**

1. Commissioner Gibson noticed some harvesting on the land between Meijer and Aldi. Director Best stated they were removing a tree that was causing damage to the fence around the retention pond.
2. Commissioner Gibson reported that he received a letter dated Dec 10th regarding the deep injection well in Romulus changing ownership.
3. Commissioner Creal reported he received an email from EGLE regarding the TMDL approved levels that was sent to the U.S.E.P.A. along with the comments that have been collected. The EPA approved the numbers 2 weeks ago. Going forward new permits will have to be pulled up and down stream.
4. Commissioner Brownlee received a question from his neighbor: "Is the Lake lowering D.O.A. or will it be revisited?" Director Best reported that the State and Federal Government will not allow the drawdown without more significant study and research into the impact of the drawdown. The township is looking into options with Eagle Creek. At this time, it is not anticipated in 2020.
5. Commissioner Brownlee requested if the commission would see the Master Plan as it would apply to Green Space? Executive Assistant Renaud reported that internally we would be getting a 70% draft next week. The draft would then be reviewed internally and then made available to the public for a 63-day comment period before being brought to the Planning Commission and the Township Board. Once the draft was in the public comment period, it could be brought to the commission so they could see the environmental direction and impact.

6. Commissioner Brownlee wanted to know what the status of the Landfill expansion is. They are still in negotiations with the State of Michigan no anticipation of any changes for 2 to 3 years. It will take another 20 years for them to get to Ecorse road if they started tomorrow.
