VAN BUREN TOWNSHIP, Mich.,- In response to Governor Whitmer's Executive Order 2020-21 to "Stay Home, Stay Safe" all Township Administration offices will remain closed until April 13, 2020. All programs and events have been canceled until further notice.

Emergency Services (Police, Fire & Dispatch) will remain open. Van Buren Township will continue to work remotely. For emergencies, such as a water main breaks, please contact the Van Buren Township Dispatch at 734-699-8930. For non-emergencies, government services and/or general questions (building permits, Focus Hope, etc.) please call 734-699-8910. Then leave a message and staff will return your call in a timely manner.

The Township is committed to supporting our at risk populations. Our Community Resource Guide identifies resources available to assist our residents seeking emergency services, as well as basic needs such as food, clothing, shelter, physical and mental health resources, employment, transportation, and more.
